SUBMISSION DETAILS

Neighborhood Watch Video Competition is open to individuals of all ages residing in Ashland, Ashtabula, Carroll, Columbiana, Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, Mahoning, Medina, Portage, Richland, Stark, Summit, Trumbull, or Wayne Counties. All submissions must be received by **Friday, May 22, 2009**. All submissions must be accompanied by a cover letter including:

- o Name, address, phone number, and email address of applicant
- o A brief description of the video (no more than 200 words)
- o Video information, including title, date, length, and production credits (if applicable)

VIDEO GUIDELINES*

- o Video can be in any style: live action, animated, slide show, etc.
- o Cannot exceed 4 minutes
- o Submitted on DVD
- o Playable on a standard DVD player
- o Include an introductory screen or image with title, date, and artist name

*Videos that do not follow the requirements will not be considered for this competition
